DAMAGE:

If you have experienced storm damage please complete a damage report regardless of severity for potential state and federal assistance. It is best practice to take pictures of the damages to your primary home. This includes multiple angles of your home and waterlines (if applicable and if able to be done safely). These pictures assist validating the scope of the damages virtually.

If someone has found a lost pet, they should try to locate the owner first before calling Animal Control.
